



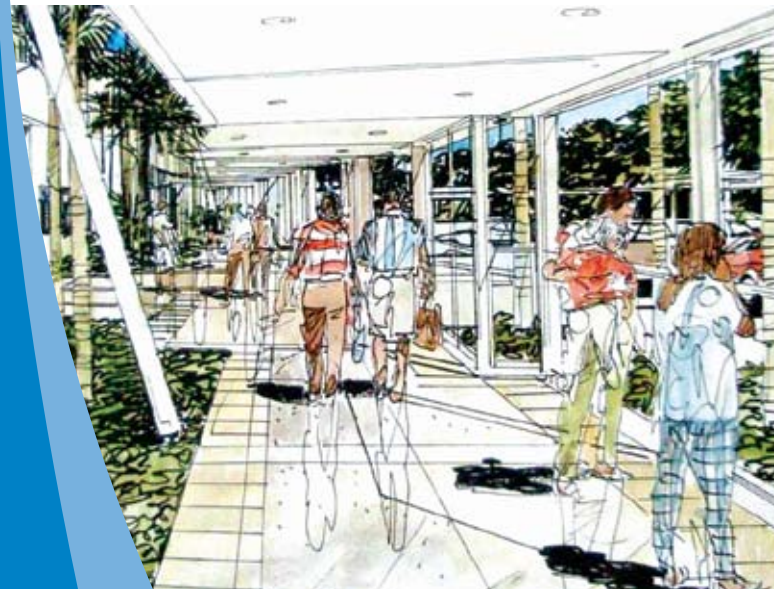
Richmond Birdwing Butterfly Project

The Richmond Birdwing Butterfly, one of Australia's most impressive and beautiful native butterflies, is under threat of extinction as a result of habitat destruction and loss of its one larval food plant.

In the hope of securing the butterflies' future on the Sunshine Coast the Airport is working with community groups to establish and provide a safe habitat in which the Richmond Birdwing Butterfly can live and breed.

Sunshine Coast Airport Terminal Redevelopment

Stage One of Sunshine Coast Airport's Master Plan is underway with the Sunshine Coast Regional Council allocating \$3.6 million to the redevelopment of the existing airport terminal and departure lounge.

The planned refurbishment will significantly enhance the travelling experience for all of the airport's commuters, visitors and staff, and ultimately deliver unprecedented economic benefits to the Sunshine Coast.

The new development, designed to reflect the natural light and feel of the Sunshine Coast region, will incorporate a unique rainforest walk as well as the creation of a Richmond Birdwing Butterfly habitat.

By providing an enhanced travelling experience for visitors the multi-million dollar refurbishment will support continued growth of the tourism industry on the Sunshine Coast.

Due to the complexity of works there may be some inconvenience to passengers, however, all efforts will be taken to minimise impact. Work is expected to be completed in late 2009.

Key Highlights

- The new design of the terminal will significantly reduce the amount of time spent in queues at the security screening point.
- Both passengers and visitors to the airport will be able to enter the more spacious departure lounge where all shops will be located and additional amenities will be provided.
- A broader retail, food and beverage experience will be available including a larger store for the Sunshine Coast's unique Jewellery Lounge. **The Jewellery Lounge**, a long-term tenant of the airport, offers a first class range of jewellery, watches and designer handbags.
