

AVIATION CHARGES SCHEDULE

These Conditions govern the provision of standard aeronautical services at the Airport. Standard aeronautical services are provided on an open access and non-discriminatory basis to all users. Airlines may negotiate additional aeronautical services in written binding agreements with SCA referred to as Aeronautical Services Agreements (ASA). Some of the terms of these Conditions may apply in addition to the terms of an ASA.

The following charges, as varied from time to time, apply for the use of Our Facilities and Services and are effective from 1 July 2020 unless otherwise indicated.

All charges exclude GST unless otherwise indicated.

Passenger Facilitation Charge (PFC)

This charge applies to all arriving and/or departing Passengers on scheduled RPT Operations and other aircraft using our Airport Terminal, unless other arrangements are agreed in writing:

Passenger Facilitation Charge	Effective from 1 July 2020
Per arriving and departing passenger movement	\$25.89

The PFC is expected to be cost-reflective, when adjusted for inflation, over the long term. It has been determined using pre Covid-19 forecasts of costs and passenger volumes, and may be updated in the future when the long term impacts of Covid-19 are better understood.

Safety & Security Charge (SSC)

This charge applies to all departing Passengers on aircraft using the Security Restricted Area unless other arrangements are agreed in writing.

The SSC will be determined by SCA and levied on a 'pass through' basis and will include direct costs incurred in providing government mandated services.

During the Aviation Relief Program period (February to December 2020) security charges will be levied monthly on total costs as a percentage of total departing passengers and split between Airlines whose passengers have utilised the Security Restricted Area during that month.

From 1 January 2021, upon cessation of the Aviation Relief Program, the SSC will be re-set on a per departing passenger basis.

Powders, Liquids, Aerosols and Gels Charge (PLAGS)

PLAGS applies to all International departing Passengers, unless other arrangements are agreed in writing.

PLAGS will be determined by SCA and levied on a 'pass through' basis and will include direct costs incurred in providing the government mandated services.

The cost per international departing passenger for PLAGS will be re-set when international services resume at the airport.

General Landing Charges (GLC)

This charge applies to all aircraft operations at our Airport, other than on scheduled RPT Operations or unless other arrangements are agreed in writing.

* For landings between 23:00-05:30 - in addition to other aeronautical charges levied

Training Exercises and Aircraft Maintenance Aerodrome Circuits

Despite the above General Landing Charges, all aircraft involved in flight training or aircraft maintenance aerodrome circuits will be charged the applicable GLC once for the first hour, and once for each hour thereafter based on the GLC as outlined above, as opposed to a charge for each landing.

Aircraft Parking Charges (APC)

1. RPT Apron

An Aircraft Parking Charge of \$527.86 per calendar day or part thereof, will apply for the use of an RPT apron.

Nil charges will apply for aircraft where the PFC is applicable and where those aircraft turnaround within four hours.

2. General Aviation

Where the aircraft is parked at the Airport (but not on the RPT apron) a charge of \$6.60 will be charged per 24-hour period or part thereof per tonne of MTOW (except where the aircraft is parked in a leased or licensed area).
